BIOGRAPHY The Rev. Dr. Don McGarity

Dr. & Mrs. (Bonnie) McGarity were born in Houston, Texas, were confirmed in the same Presbyterian Church, sang in the choir together and in 1965 were married by their Presbyterian minister. In December they will celebrate their 56th Anniversary. They have two children, four grandchildren and 5 great-grandchildren.

After a career in Music, Dr. McGarity felt the call to the ministry. In 1972 the McGarity's moved from Houston to Austin, TX where he attended and graduated from Austin Presbyterian Theological Seminary with a Master of Divinity (1975). He later received his doctorate in 1981 at McCormick Theological Seminary, Chicago.

He served churches in Texas before becoming the Senior Pastor of First Presbyterian Church, Jacksonville, FL. Rev. McGarity then became the organizing and founding pastor of the Amelia Plantation Chapel, an Interdenominational Community Church established by the presbytery in the Resort of Amelia Island Plantation.

The McGarity's retired to Gainesville because of the religious, educational and fine arts opportunities as well as the excellent medical facilities. In retirement he has served as Stated Supply at Bethlehem Presbyterian, Archer and 1st Presbyterian, Starke, More recently he was Area One Relationship Coordinator for the Presbytery of St. Augustine which included Perry. He retired for a 3rd time in November.

Since moving to Gainesville Dr. McGarity has been involved locally at various times with First Presbyterian Church, St. Frances House, The Gainesville Pops, The Gainesville Community Band, Shands Institutional Review Board, Oak Hammock and The Village Retirement Communities. He established the Volunteer Chaplaincy Program at Oak Hammock when it opened in 2004.
