## A study of the book of Romans

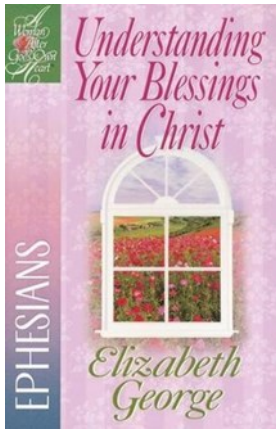
